

## Pupil absence

I have a duty of care to ensure that every child has a good attendance. If a child's attendance drops to 94% or below, the school follows the attendance policy (found on our school website) and letters must be issued; reminding parents of their responsibility to ensure their children attend school when fit and healthy to do so.

We understand of course, that our children can become very poorly and would need to miss school. However coughs and colds are always going to be part of a child's life and we are happy to have them in and provide that extra TLC. When suffering with a small cold, we recommend Calpol or similar, before they come to school. Of course, if they start to feel poorly during the day, we would call you. We are also happy to administer antibiotics; so long as the medicine is in a labelled bottle and accompanied with an administer form found on our website http://www.cadmoreendschool.org/website/medicine\_administer/334469

The only time we expect children to be absent is if they have sickness, diarrhoea or a contagious illness such as Chicken Pox. Currently our whole school attendance is 96.2%.
