

### English

Our reading & writing will be based around 'The Girl of Ink & Stars' by Karen Millward Hargreaves and Greek 'Myths & Legends'. We will also do some follow-up writing from our visit to Quinta

### Science

In Science we are looking at forces-air resistance, levers, pulleys and gravity and light - how we see things and how light travels, shadows.

### Art/DT

In Art we are making Greek tragedy masks, Greek mosaic pictures and observational drawings of Greek artefacts. We will also be making and tasting Greek food

ClubSport will continue to teach multi-skills and we will be learning the rules and skills required for the game of Rounders and practising 'athletics' skills for reading for Sports Day

### History

We will be studying the Ancient Greeks. What life was like, achievements and influence on the western world

### RE

We are continuing to explore 'Islam' in answering our 'I wonder...' questions and this will include a visit to a mosque this half-term. We will also be considering 'What Would Jesus Do' (WWJD) through the gospel of Mark.

### Music

### Maths
