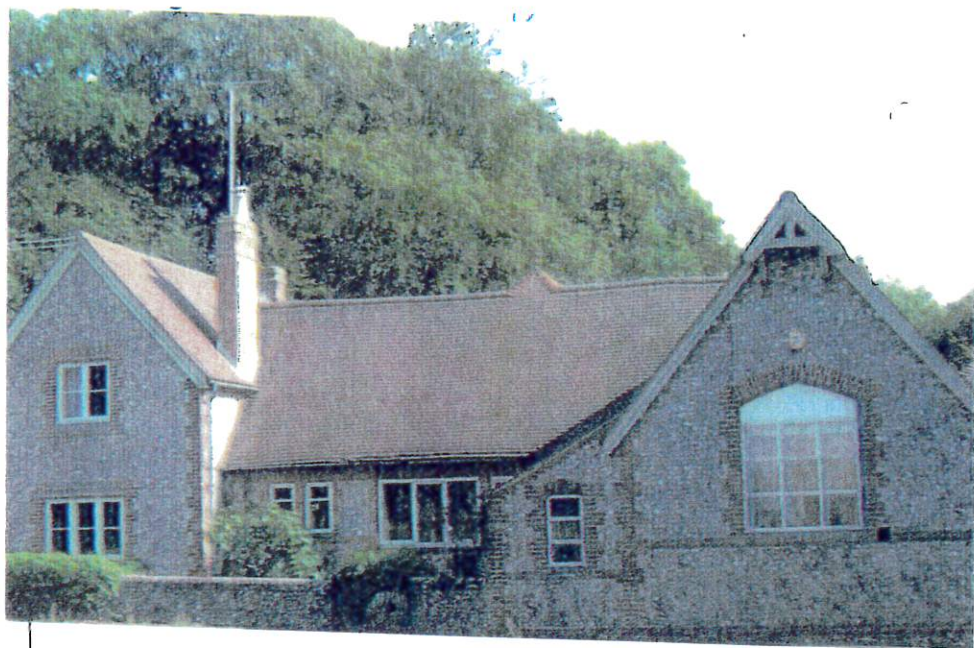


Have You Heard of Cadmore end school?

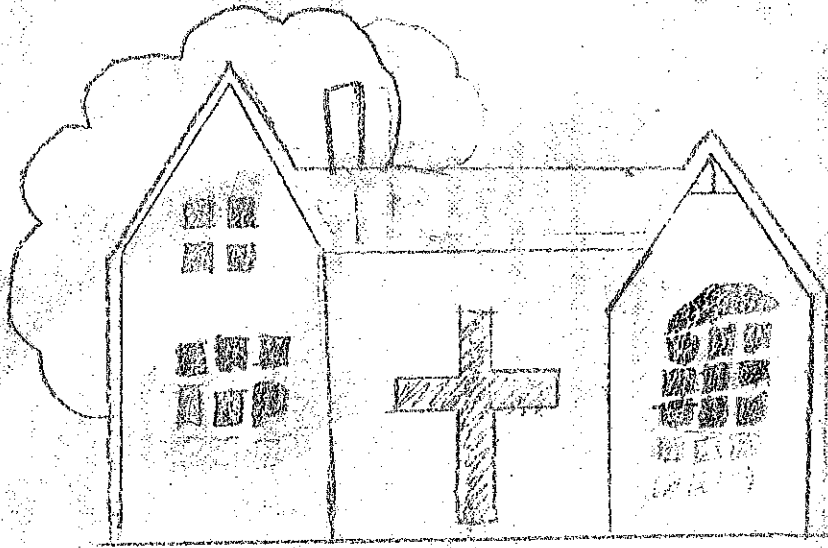

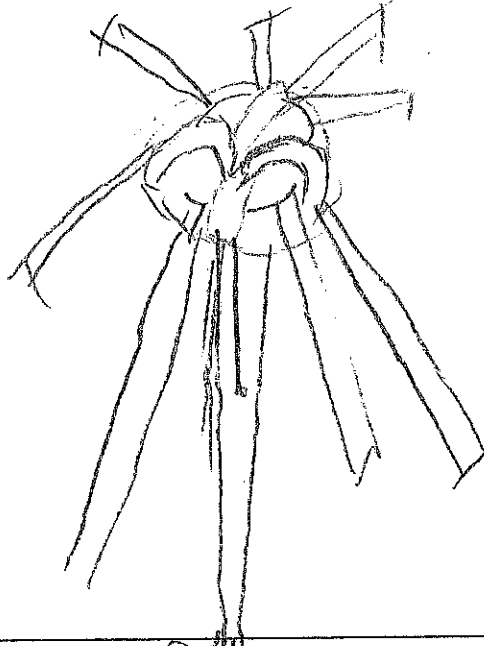

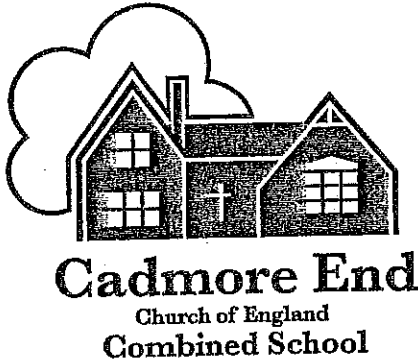

The Teaching at cadmore end is really good because it is fun and the learn lots. The grounds in cadmore end may be small but the have a large playground and a gigantic forest school area.

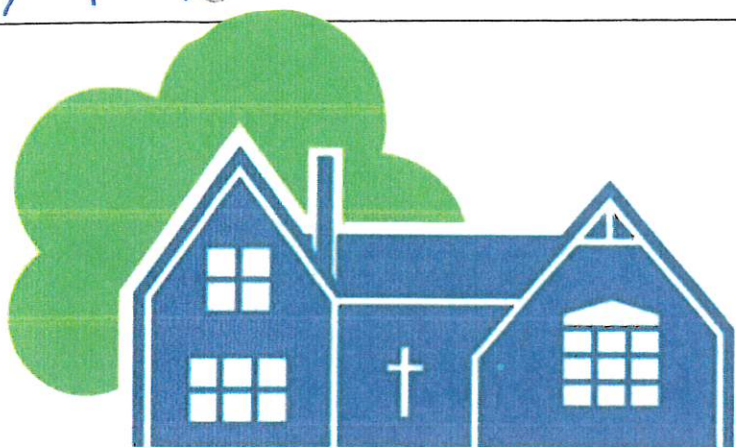
This school is small and has many little pupils but you make good friends.
