8.50 Welcome and early morning activities to settle in.


9.00 Nursery group time (learning about sounds, listening games, stories and songs).

11.30 Nursery group time (learning about colours, shapes, counting and numbers).

11.40 Getting ready to go home.

11.50 Home time.



Each child has a diary at school which is completed most days by Mrs Hazel. The diary will consist of pictures and comments of significant events that have taken place. The diary will also be sent home for you to take a look and add to.

This term we will be focusing on "Elmer" stories as well as enjoying lots of other fun stories and rhymes.

Our **Forest School** session takes place on **Thursday mornings** with **Mrs Hazell** and **Mrs Maughan**. Please make sure **all** Forest School clothing are **clearly labelled** (including the bag) and are kept in school until the end of ½ term. Look out for our Forest school newsletter.

Every **Friday** the children may bring in a small '**Show & Tell**' item that they can show and talk about to the whole class. The children thoroughly enjoy these sessions. Please note that no other toys are allowed in school.
