Dear Parents,

Between Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> Ap**ril** until Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> July - excluding May 17<sup>th</sup> (SAT's week) May 24<sup>th</sup> (class 4 residential trip) and 31<sup>st</sup> May (half term) for 9 weeks in total, years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will be attending Handy Cross leisure centre for swimming lessons. It is the schools duty to ensure that when children leave they are able to swim 25m length confidently. We understand that some of the children already swim to a high level but we will be taking all of the children as part of their PE lessons. The children will get the required exercise and will be able to develop their swimming skills.

## SWIMWEAR

Boys – swimming trunks or shorts. Please note that shorts are to be close fitting and well above the knee. Instructors at the pool prefer trunks as there is less drag through the water. Girls – one piece swimming costume, no bikinis.

Swim hats must be worn by all boys and girls regardless of hair length. All jewellery must be removed. Please ensure that your child does not bring any aerosols with them. If they do want to use a deodorant then please supply them with a roll-on, so that we comply with health and safety guidelines

Children should only wear goggles if there is a medical need, if so please tick the box below. This has to be updated every year so we follow county guidelines. If your child needs to wear goggles then they must be able put them on/take them off themselves and will have to wear them the whole time they are poolside.

The school will be funding the cost of the lessons out of our PE grant but ask for a voluntary contribution of £30.00 per child to pay for the travel costs (we are not allowed to pay for this out of the grant). This is still good value for money and works out at just £3.33 per session for this valuable life skill. Unfortunately we are unable to refund any payments for missed lessons.
