New Maths Learning Platform

We have a free 60 day free trial of [RM easimaths](https://www.rm-easimaths.com/). This programme is different to Mathletics as the programme has an inbuilt diagnostic system which enables the programme to provide questions that consolidate and challenge children's learning in maths. Over the course of this weekend, you will receive login details for your child.

Each animated session is set at 15 minutes and should be completed by the child without help. Please encourage your child to have a go next week **instead** of completing Matheletics.
