Attendance and Punctuality

Just a reminder that, In line with recent DFE recommendations, we have extended our school day by 5 minutes. ALL children must be in school and seated by 8:45am. Gates will open at 8:35 (closed at 8:43am). School will finish at 3:15pm.

To monitor attendance and punctuality, we will be carrying out weekly attendance and punctuality checks. Parents of children whose attendance and punctuality fall below 94% will receive an attendance and punctuality notification and will be closely monitored. Persistent absence or lateness could result in a fixed penalty notice or face prosecution by Buckinghamshire Council.

Healthcare Plans

If your child has any medical needs and you have not already done so, please could you complete a healthcare plan that has been attached to this email. We are happy for you to fill out the form electronically and to email it back to office@cadmoreendschool.org Please ensure that all completed forms are returned immediately so that the correct support can be provided.
