

# Spring 2 Curriculum Overview

## English:

We will start back this half term looking at creating our own narrative piece of writing based on 'Fantastic Mr Fox'.

This will allow us to recap some basic writing skills such as adding expanded noun phrases and word classes to our sentences as well as learning and developing some new skills such as writing dialogue and using speech marks.

We will also be writing non-chronological reports based on our topic of mountains.

We will do some research to help us include some interesting facts in our report.

## Maths:

This half term will focus on recapping some basic skills and stretching our place value knowledge.

We will be looking at decimals numbers. We will practice our calculation strategies by using them to help solve problems and using them in a wide variety of contexts, such as with time and money.

## Science:

This half term is all about plants. We will continue to learn about what plants need to survive, the anatomy of plants, life cycle and how plants use water effectively.

## Topic:

Our topic this half term is geography based and is all about mountains. We will learn about the mountain ranges around the world, altitude and life on mountain ranges.

## Art/DT

Our Art this half term is linked to our topic of mountains. Developing our landscape drawing and working up to making creating prints.

## ICT

This half term we will be practicing our coding but having a go at programming objects to follow a path.

## RE

We will be continuing to look at Christianity with a focus on the Bible. We will be exploring bible stories and their significance and importance to the Christian religion.

## PSHCE

This half term is all about the world people who are important to us. Looking at secrets and who we can talk to when we have something important to share and who we can trust.
