If you have some containers put a number 1-5 on them & practice throwing your ball, bean bag, paper or socks into the containers & naming the number.	Can you practice your throwing skill with a ball, bean bag screwed up paper or even a ball of socks to your grown up & catching it back.

Friday 29th	Choose one of your favourite stories to share with your grown up, when you have finished can you remember what the story was about, who were the characters & what happened to them.	On a small chair use the preposition words from Tuesday but this time put yourself in the positions when asked by your grown up but stay safe.	Can you draw a picture of the character or your favourite part of your story that you shared today.
