## COVID 19

We continue to be extremely fortunate not to have any cases of COVID within school. However, as you will be aware, the number of cases of Covid continue to rise. We continue to ask for your support in being cautious and vigilant. In particular, we are asking your help with PCR testing your children (or other family members) if they are showing any one or more symptom of COVID 19:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- you've lost your sense of smell or taste or it's changed

If you live in the same household as someone with COVID-19, you should stay at home and self-isolate. If you are fully vaccinated or aged under 18 years and 6 months you are not required to self-isolate if you are a contact of someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.
