## SPRING TERM CURRICULUM NEWS!



English

We will begin this term with the book 'The Whales' Song'.



The children will learn all about whales and how to describe them to each other using descriptive sentences. They will use the structure of the story to write their own story, concentrating on punctuating sentences correctly and using adjectives and expanded noun phrases to extend their sentences.



We will then go onto 'Playing with language'. We will use the book 'Walking the bridge of your nose' to get our tongues around tongue twisters and writing mixed up nursery rhymes and nonsense poems.

#### Maths

We will start with a unit on Multiplication, where we will use clever counting as a tool to help us as well as relating multiplication to division. We will then have another look at fractions, followed with a unit on 2D and 3D shape and symmetry.

#### Science

We have already started our topic for science this term. So far we have looked at flowers and trees in our natural environment. We will also be learning about the structure of plants and trees and what they

need to grow well. We will be identifying common plants and trees in the garden and in the wild, as well as sorting leaves and planting our



PE

In PE we will be doing gymnastics and running and jumping skills.



#### PHSE

Our main focus will be 'Being Happy', we will be learning some



growth mindset skills to enable us to aim high and also the importance of working together as a team.

#### RE

We will start by thinking about 'Friendship' and about what it means to be a good friend. Then we will be thinking about surprises, which leads on to Easter and why it is such an important time for Christians.



#### Geography

We will be continuing to develop our key map skills in Geography by exploring a range of maps at a local, national and global level. We will learn how to navigate around an atlas to find key countries, continents, oceans and seas.

We are going to use Purple Mash to help us become story book animators...watch this space!
