## Summer 1 Curriculum Overview

English: This half term we will begin by looking at poems. We will be looking at different types of poetry and their features. We will perform poems as well as write a poem in the style of one already written. We will then move on to our narrative unit based on the book 'Odd and the Frost Giants'. A novel linked to our topic of 'The Vikings'. We will look closely at the characters and use the text to help us recognise and understand topical language and learn about clauses to help develop our sentence structures.	Maths: This half term we will be focusing on fractions, time and multiplication and division. We will start by looking at fractions. Recognising them in their number format as well as pictorial representations. We will learn how to find fractions of amounts as well as add and subtract fractions with both the same and different denominators. We will move onto time looking at digital and analogue clocks and recognising how to tell and read the time and us our knowledge of time to solve problems. We will finish the term by recapping some multiplication and division strategies.	Science: This half term is all about animals including humans,. We will be learning about bones and skeletons in both animals and humans. We will be exploring how different animals have adapted to have different skeletons and bone structures. We will learn about muscles and how to keep our bodies healthy.	Topic: Our topic this half term is history based and will focus on the Vikings. We will learn about how they came to travel from their home lands to settle in Great Britain. We will learn about their home life, including jobs, diet and fashion. We will explore their beliefs and discover why we learn about them today.
Art/DT Our Art this half term will have links to our topic but will also look at developing our art skills. We will use our knowledge of Vikings to create Viking art work.	Music: Our music this half term will look at drumming and rhythm.	RE We will be continuing to look at Islam. We will be learning about Muslim special places, celebrations and look closely at their belief system.	PSHCE This half term is all about Diverse Britain. We will be learning about what makes Britain unique, human rights and democracy.
