<u>Monday 11th</u>	Describe it find it! Put 4 toy animals in a bag and get your grown up to describe one at a time for you to guess. Can you make the noises of the animals?	Number snap Make 2 sets of number cards (1-5 or 10) and play snap with your grown ups at home.	Can you practice your scissor skills making snips in paper or following a line or maybe cutting up a play dough sausage
Tuesday 12 th	Letter finger paint Get your grown up to write the first 1 or 2 letters of your name on a piece of paper and trace it with finger print paint dots.	Number walk If you go on a walk have a look and see what numbers you can spot out and about (e.g. door numbers, road signs, car registrations).	If you have some sand or flour you could practice with a stick or your finger making letters or numbers
Wednesday 14 th	Sounds Get your grown up to play the clip and pause it after each sound. Can you guess which of the pictures the sound matches to? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=1ankzQP0ae4	Get your grown up to hide your number cards (from Monday) around your home and search for them and match them with the correct one.	What do the police do for us? Could you make a police badge or radio from a small box from your recycling
Thursday 15 th	Describe it find it! Repeat the activity from Monday but change the objects you use this time.
