Internet safety

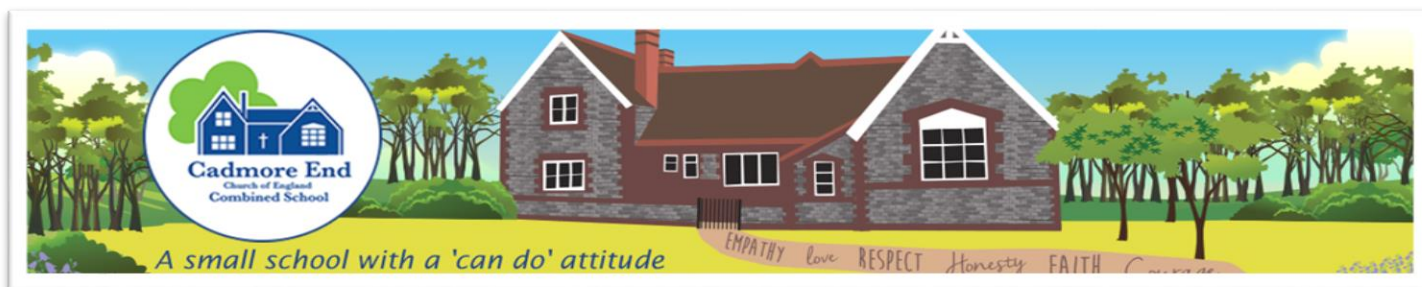
